






North End Historical Society of Boston, MA

NEHS is currently working on two major projects to celebrate the rich cultural history of the North End.

The Noble Journey Sculpture

In partnership with other area institutions, NEHS is raising funds to install a bronze sculpture at St. Leonard Church in Boston's North End to symbolize the first steps down a gangway from Italy to America which Italian and other immigrants walked after crossing the Atlantic. These footprints lead directly into the first Italian Catholic Church in New England. It will remind all visitors of the values, challenges, courage, and dedication it took to make the immigrant vision a reality, and inspire its continuity and evolution.

North End Neighborhood Museum

The NEHS sees it as its mission and responsibility to acquire an appropriate exhibition space for a public display of items that illustrate North End neighborhood history. This facility would involve touch-screen displays, exhibition space for historic artifacts, and a gallery dedicated to the unique history of the Italians in Boston.

NEHS Programming

- Production and distribution of the documentary film Boston's North End: An Italian American Story (2016), which is available for streaming on the NEHS website, https://northendboston.org/.
- Creation of a 40-minute video about Street Corner Society that includes interviews with author, William Foote Whyte as well as two North End "corner boys" who were featured in the book, Ralph Orlandella and Al Natale.
- Thematic tours for NEHS members of North End landmarks and institutions in the company of experts in history, art, architecture, and other cultural studies.
- Book launches, film screenings, newsletters, and many other ways to engage and connect with the community!
